

ORDINANCE # 269 BY MAULE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION #1 OF ORDINANCE #213, OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, Idaho,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO,

That Section #1 of Ordinance #213 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled "An ordinance providing for licensing of draymen, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof, and repealing all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith," passed by the mayor and council and approved by the mayor of the said city on the 15th day of January, 1912,

Be and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

First. That each and every person, firm, or corporation who hauls or transports for hire or profit any goods, wares, merchandise, package, produce, or building material of any kind, from one place to another within the corporate limits of the city of Payette, for any other person or persons, firm, association, or corporation, shall for the purpose of this ordinance, be deemed a drayman and doing a drayage business, and shall pay a license fee of \$5.00 per quarter per team, vehicle, or other conveyance.
