

ORDINANCE # 270 BY JOHNSON

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION #1 OF ORDINANCE #9 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

That Ordinance #9 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled "An ordinance requiring official bond of certain officers of the City of Payette, Idaho", passed by the mayor and council of the said City of Payette, and approved by the mayor thereof on the 9th day of September, 1903,

Be and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

Section #1. The Clerk, Treasurer, Police Judge, Marshall, Night Marshall or Policeman, and the City Engineer, before entering upon the duties of their offices, shall file with the Clerk good sufficient bonds with sufficient sureties, to be approved by the council, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of their respective offices, in the following amounts, to-wit:

The Clerk in the sum of ~~10000.00~~,
The Treasurer in the sum of ~~15000.00~~,
The Police Judge in the sum of \$500.00,
The Marshall in the sum of \$1,000.00,
The Night Marshall or Policeman, in the sum of \$1,000.00,
The City Engineer in the sum of \$2,000.00.
