

ORDINANCE NO. 274 BY Ryzae, Egan & Crouch

AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION AND LEVY FOR GENERAL ROAD, AND SALARY PURPOSES AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE REDEMPTION OF OUTSTANDING BONDED INDEBTEDNESS, AND THE PAYMENT OF THE INTEREST ON THE OUTSTANDING BONDED INDEBTEDNESS.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1915, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of two and six tenths (2-6/10) Mills on each one dollar of the valuation of said property, and the funds realized from such levy, together with all licenses and ~~and all moneys not otherwise disposed of~~ fines, shall be placed in the general fund of the said City of Payette.

Section 2. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1915, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of four (4) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such ~~city~~ property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the salary fund of such city.

Section 3. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1915, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of three and six tenths (3-6/10) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the road fund of the said City of Payette.

Section 4. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1915, against all the taxable property located within the corporate limits of said city of Payette, the sum of five tenths (5/10) of one mill on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property

and the funds realized from such assessment shall be placed in the street lighting fund of the said City of Payette,

Section 5. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May 1915, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of four and three tenths (4-3/10) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the bond interest fund of said City of Payette.

Section 6. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1915, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of said city of Payette, the sum of two (2) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the bond sinking fund of the said City of Payette.

Section <sup>b</sup> That the sum of \$2954.50, together with all <sup>is</sup> fines and moneys not otherwise appropriated ~~are~~, hereby appropriated for the general expense of the City of Payette, Idaho, for the fiscal year ending on the first Tuesday in May, 1916.

Section <sup>7</sup> That the sum of \$4610. is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending on the first Tuesday in May 1916, for the purpose of paying all salaries <sup>a</sup> of the various officers of the said City of Payette, and the same shall constitute ~~x~~ the salary fund for such purpose.

Section <sup>8</sup> That the sum of \$4025. is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, for the purpose of building and keeping in repair all roads and streets within the corporate limits of said city, and the same shall constitute ~~x fund~~ <sup>the</sup> road fund of said city.

Section <sup>9</sup> That the sum of \$565. is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending on the first Tuesday in May, 1916,

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for the purpose of paying the expenses of lighting the streets of the said City of Payette, and the funds realized from such levy shall constitute the ~~salary fund~~ <sup>Street Lighting Fund</sup> for such purpose.

Section **10** That the sum of \$4994 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, and for the purpose of paying all interest on all general bond issues of the said City of Payette, and the same shall constitute the bond interest fund of said city.


Section 12. That the sum of \$2259. is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, for the purpose of maintaining a sinking fund of the said City of Payette, to be distributed pro rata to the various funds now created and established for paying off the bonded indebtedness of said city, as the same matures, and the same shall constitute the bond sinking fund of the said City.
