

ORDINANCE NO. 303 by

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING " SECTIONS 11,14,15 and 16" AND REPEALING "SECTION 12" OF ORDINANCE NO. 241 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ENTITLED, " AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ORGANIZATION AND GOVERNMENT OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF".

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1.

That section eleven of Ordinance No. 241 of the City of Payette, Idaho, passed and approved the 5th day of August, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11. Any able bodied citizen of the City of Payette, Idaho, over eighteen years of age, may become a member of the department when there is a vacancy, by being duly appointed by the fire chief, and by taking and filing with the City Clerk of the said City of Payette, an oath to support the constitution of the State of Idaho, and the ordinances of the City of Payette, and to faithfully perform the duties of his respective office according to the best of his ability.

Section 2.

That section fourteen of Ordinance No. 241 of the City of Payette, Idaho, passed and approved the 5th day of August, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 14. Any drayman or other person pulling the fire apparatus to a fire shall be entitled to the sum of \$2.00.

Section 3.

That section fifteen of ordinance No. 241 of the City of Payette, Idaho, passed and approved the 5th day of August, 1913 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 15. Any person or persons interfering with the firemen in the discharge of their duties, or by passing over the fire hose with any vehicle drawn or propelled by horse or motor, shall upon conviction thereof be fined in the sum of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00. Any person or persons who shall be guilty of removing any ladder or other fire apparatus from any of the fire stations for any purpose except to fight fire without first obtaining the consent and authority of the Chairman of the Fire Committee or the Fire Chief so to do, shall upon conviction thereof be fined in any sum not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00.

Section 4.

That section sixteen of ordinance No. 241 of the City of Payette, Idaho, passed and approved the 5th day of August, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 16. A copy of the minutes of all meetings of the Fire Department shall be turned over to the Chairman of the Fire Committee immediately after each meeting. It shall be the duty of the Fire Chief to submit an itemized report to the City Clerk of the City of Payette of the attendance of the said

department at each fire and the amount due each member for services rendered at each fire.

Section 5.

That section twelve of Ordinance No. 241 of the City of Payette, Idaho, passed and approved the 5th day of August, 1913, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 6.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of the City of Payette, Idaho.
