

ORDINANCE NO. 304 by Swanson

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "SECTION 1" OF ORDINANCE NO. 126, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 232, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 249 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE FIRE LIMITS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE AND PROVIDING FOR THE PREVENTION OF FIRES THEREIN, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF".

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1,

That section one of Ordinance No. 126, as amended by Ordinance No. 232, as amended by ordinance no. 249 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled "An ordinance fixing the fire limits within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, and providing for the prevention of fires therein, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof", passed and approved the 5th day of June, 1908, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The West one-half of block one (1), six (6) and seven (7) and all of block two (2), three (3), five (5) and eight (8) in Gorrie's Addition to the City of Payette, Idaho; also the west one-half of block nine (9), the northwest quarter of block three (3) and all of block four (4) in Masters original townsite as described upon the official plat of the City of Payette, Idaho, as platted and recorded in the office of the recorder of Payette County, Idaho, be and are hereby declared to be within the fire limits of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of the City of Payette, Idaho.
