

ORDINANCE NO. 210. BY

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "SECTION 1" OF ORDINANCE NO. 19 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ENTITLED " AN ORDINANCE FORBIDDING INTERFERENCE WITH CITY OFFICERS OR IMPERSONATING PEACE OFFICERS, AND FIXING THE PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF."

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1.

That section one of Ordinance No. 19 of the City of Payette, Idaho, passed and approved the 9th day of September, 1903, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Any person who shall molest, interrupt, hinder or prevent any public officer of the City in the discharge of his duties or such duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Council, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in a sum not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, together with costs of prosecution.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of the City of Payette, Idaho.
