

ORDINANCE NO. 318 By Mungom

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BOOK OF ORDINANCES.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the city of  
Payette, Idaho:

Section 1.

The foregoing ordinances of the City of Payette, Idaho, embracing twenty-two chapters, exclusive of this ordinance, revised and compiled by John H. Norris, City Attorney, together with the printed matter preceeding said ordinances and the index have been printed, published and bound in book form by authority of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, in harmony with section 2276 a, Chapter 155 page 1019 of the Compiled Laws of Idaho; said ordinances shall be received in evidence in all courts and places without further proof, in conformity with said act.

Section 2.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances of a general character passed by the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, saving and excepting the general ordinances published and bound herewith by the authority aforesaid are hereby repealed, provided that all rights acquired, and all suits, actions or proceedings pending or rounded in point of time prior to the date hereof shall and may be maintained and prosecuted, unaffected by any provision of this ordinance.

Section 3.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of the City of Payette, Idaho.
