

ORDINANCE NO. 31

An ordinance to restrain, prohibit and suppress houses of assignation and prostitution; to provide for the punishment ^{of} lewd and dissolute persons who live in and about houses of ill fame, common prostitutes, and to provide a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette.

Section II. Every person who keeps any house for the purpose of assignation or prostitution, or any house of public resort, by which the peace, comfort or decency of the immediate neighborhood is disturbed; and every person who rents or leases any house of assignation or prostitution, or knowingly permits it to be used; every person who lives in or about a house of ill fame; and every common prostitute living within the limits of the City of Payette for the purpose of prostitution, shall be deemed ^{guilty of} a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall, for every ^{such} offense, be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars, recoverable with costs, and in default of payment, shall be confined in jail not to exceed fifty days.

Section II. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
