

ORDINANCE NO. 322 by BLAIR.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING AN ANNUAL APPROPRIATION AND LEVY FOR GENERAL,  
SALARY, ROAD, STREET LIGHTING AND THE PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON THE OUTSTANDING  
BONDED INDEBTEDNESS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1.

That the sum of \$5,500.00, together with all fines and moneys not otherwise appropriated, is hereby appropriated for the General Expenses of the City of Payette, Idaho, for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A. D. 1919. *6000*

Section 2.

That the sum of \$7,500.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A. D. 1919, for the purpose of building and keeping in repair all roads and streets within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho. *7500*

Section 3.

That the sum of \$6,500.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A. D. 1919, for the purpose of paying all salaries of the various officers of the City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Salary Fund for such purposes. *7500*

Section 4.

That the sum of \$4,500.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A. D. 1919, for the purpose of lighting the streets and public thoroughfares of the City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Street Lighting Fund of the City of Payette, Idaho. *4500*

Section 5.

That the sum of \$9,000.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A. D. 1919, for the purpose of paying all interest on all the Municipal Bond issues of the City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Bond Interest Fund of the City of Payette, Idaho. *9000*

Section 6.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A. D. 1919, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of .004 mills, on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property, and the funds realized from such levy, together with all licenses and fines and all moneys not otherwise disposed of, shall be placed in the General Fund of the City of Payette, Idaho. *3 mills*

Section 7.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A. D. 1919, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of .006 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Road Fund of the City of Payette, Idaho. *6 Mills*

Section 8.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the First Tuesday in May, A. D. 1919, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of .005 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Salary Fund of the City of Payette, Idaho. *6 Mills*

Section 9.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A. D. 1919, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of .0035 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Street Lighting Fund of the City of Payette, Idaho.

*3 1/2 mills*

Section 10.

m That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A. D. 1919, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the city of Payette, Idaho, the sum of .0075 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Bond Interest Funds of the City of Payette, Idaho.

*7 1/2 mills*

Section 11.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper.
