

ORDINANCE NO. 325 By Swanson

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 245 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ENTITLED: " AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE FROM THE SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, AND FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF THE COSTS OF REMOVAL THEREOF TO THE PROPERTY ABUTTING THEREON, WHEN THE OWNER, TENANT OR OCCUPANT FAILS TO REMOVE THE SAME, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH."

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. of

That Section 2 Ordinance No. 245 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled: "An Ordinance Providing for the removal of snow and ice from the sidewalks within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, and for the assessment of the costs of removal thereof to the property abutting thereon, when the owner, tenant or occupant fails to remove the same, and repealing ordinances in conflict herewith;" passed by the Mayor and Council, and approved by the Mayor of said city on the 17th. day of November, 1913, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 2.

That the owner, tenant or occupant of any property located within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, who shall fail, neglect or refuse to remove any snow or ice from any sidewalk fronting, adjoining or abutting on any such property so owned or occupied by him for a period of two hours after the snow shall cease to fall to any appreciable extent during the day, or before ten o'clock A. M. when any snow shall have fallen during the night, shall be guilty of maintaining a nuisance, and such snow or ice is hereby declared a nuisance, and it shall be and hereby is declared to be the duty of the City of Payette to, within a reasonable time remove said snow and ice and charge the abutting, adjoining or contiguous property for the expenses and charges of such removal, and to certify such expenses to the tax Collector of Payette County, or other proper officer, for collection of the same as other city taxes are collected, and said expenses and charges shall be and hereby are declared to be a lien on such property the same as any other city taxes.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from, and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of the City of Payette, Idaho.
