

ORDINANCE NO. 376 BY: Shurwood

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING THE ENTIRE ALLEY RUNNING ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF BLOCKS 16,17,18 and 19 OF GORRIE'S ADDITION TO PAYETTE IDAHO AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NUMBERED 209 and 211.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1.

That the alley running along the East side of Blocks, 16, 17, 18 and 19 of Gorrie's Addition to Payette, Idaho, beginning at the Northeast corner of block 19 of said Gorrie's Addition,, thence East to the West line of the East half of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of section 34, township 9 North, Range 5 West of the Boise Meridian, in Payette County, Idaho; Thence South along said West line to a point East of the Southeast corner of said Block 16 of said Addition; thence West to the Southeast corner of said block 16; thence North along the East lines of said Blocks 16,17,18 and 19 to the place of beginning, except therefrom the intersection of said alley with First Avenue North, Second Avenue North and Third Avenue North and the alleys running through said Blocks 16,17 and 18 in an East and West direction be and the same is hereby vacated and closed.

Section 2.

That ordinance No; 209 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled, "An ordinance closing and disposing of the entire alley running along the East side of blocks 16,17,18 and 19 of Gorrie's Addition to Payette, Idaho, and ordinance No. 211 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled, "An ordinance amending ordinance No. 209 of the City of Payette entitled "An ordinance closing and disposing of the entire alley running along the East side of Blocks 16,17,18 and 19 of Gorrie's Addition to Payette, Idaho", be and the same are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper.
