

ORDINANCE NO. 327

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING THAT PART OF FIRST AVENUE SOUTH IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT: BEGINNING AT THE NORTH WEST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF FIRST AVENUE SOUTH AND SIXTH STREET IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO; THENCE WEST 75 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 100 FEET; THENCE EAST 75 FEET; THENCE NORTH 100 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1:

That all that part of first avenue south in the City of Payette, Idaho, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the North west corner of the intersection of first avenue South and Sixth street in the City of Payette, Idaho; thence West 75 feet; thence South 100 feet; thence East 75 feet; thence North 100 feet to the place of beginning, be and the same is hereby vacated and closed.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper.
