

ORDINANCE NO. 361 by Christman

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGING OF FIRE ARMS AND PROHIBITING THE CARRYING OR USING ANY DEVICE OR WEAPON COMMONLY KNOWN AS A FLIPPER, AND PROHIBITING THE CARRYING OR USING OF ANY WEAPON COMMONLY KNOWN AS AN AIR GUN, WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any fire arm within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, except in necessary defence of life, person or property, or when rendered necessary when making an arrest.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person to carry, or use for amusement or otherwise, or have in his or her possession, the device or weapon commonly known as a flipper (it being an India rubber strap or a spring used to throw small rocks or other hard substances.)

Section 3: It shall be unlawful for any person to carry, use for amusement or otherwise, or have in his or her possession within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the device or weapon commonly known as an air gun or spring gun.

Section 4: Any person violating any of the provisions of Section 1, 2 or 3 of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof be fined in any amount not exceeding \$100.00.
