ORDINANCE NO. 365 BY

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING THEATERS AND MOVING PICTURE SHOWS TO KEEP OPEN ON SUNDAY IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ACCORDING TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 8293 OF IDAHO COMPILED STATUTES, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 238 OF THE 1921 SESSION LAWS OF IDAHO.

WHEREAS, by the provisions of Section 8293 of the Idaho Compiled Statutes, as amended by Chapter 238 of the 1921 Session Laws of Idaho, it is provided that the Council of any City in the State of Idaho may pass an ordinance permitting theaters and moving picture shows to keep open on Sunday therein, provided a number of the qualified electors of said City, equal to a majority of the votes cast at the last general election therein, shall petition said Council to permit theaters and moving picture shows to keep open on Sunday therein; and

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the Council of said City of Payette a petition signed by qualified electors residing within the limits of said City of Payette, equal in number to a majority of the votes cast at the last general election therein, asking that theaters and moving picture shows be permitted to keep open on Sunday therein:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDIANED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

SECTION 1. That it shall be lawful for theaters and moving picture shows to keep open in the City of Payette, Idaho, on Sunday between the hours of 2:00 O'clock P.M., and 12 O'clock midnight, and said theaters and moving picture shows are hereby permitted to keep open in the said City of Payette, Idaho, on Sunday between the hours of 2:00 O'clock P.M., and 12 O'clock midnight.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
