

*Master's Original Townsite of Payette,*  
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ORDINANCE NO. ~~37~~ 38

An ordinance to provide for the construction of sidewalks on Broad street, Main street, Mill street, Park street, Grand Avenue and Tdoga street, in Payette, establishing local improvement districts Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, & 7, and providing that the cost and expense of such improvements shall be taxed and assessed upon all the property in such local improvement districts.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section I. That a sidewalk shall be constructed on the west side of Broad street from Payette avenue to Ada avenue.

Section II. That a sidewalk shall be constructed on the west side of Broad street from Ada avenue to the walk now constructed on the east side of block three, Gorrie's addition to Payette, and that Local Improvement District number one is hereby established bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the south east corner of block one Master's Original Townsite, of Payette, running thence west to the center of the alley in said block one, thence north to the center of block three in said Master's Original Townsite of Payette, thence west to the west line of Broad street, and thence south to the place of beginning.

Section III. That a sidewalk shall be constructed on the south side of Main street from Fulton street to Gorrie street, and that Local Improvement District No. 2 is hereby established ~~and~~ bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the north west corner of block sixteen, ~~Master's addition to Payette,~~ thence east to the north east corner of block twenty one, Melcher's addition to Payette, thence south to the center of the alley in said block twenty-one, thence west to the east side of Gorrie street, thence north to the place of beginning.

Section IV. That a sidewalk shall be constructed on the south side of Main street from Boise street to the sidewalk as now constructed on the north side of block nine ~~Original Town of Payette,~~ and that Local Improvement District No. 3 is hereby established, ~~and~~ bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the north west corner of block nine ~~Original Townsite of Payette,~~ running thence east to the center of the alley in said block nine, thence south to the south east corner of lot five in said block, thence west to the east line of Boise street thence north to the place of beginning.

Section V. That a sidewalk shall be constructed on the south side of Mill street between Boise street and Park street, and that Local Improvement District No. 4 is hereby established, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the north west corner of block six Gorrie's addition to Payette, thence running east to the north east corner of said block, thence south to the south east corner of lot fifteen in said block thence west to the east line of Boise street, thence north to the place of beginning.

Section VI. That a sidewalk shall be constructed on the north side of Mill street from Park street to Gorrie street, and that a sidewalk shall be constructed on the south side of Mill street, from Gorrie street to Pence street, and that Local Improvement District No. 5 is hereby established, bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the south west corner of block thirteen, Gorrie's addition to Payette, thence running north to the north west corner of lot five in said block, thence east to the east side of block eighteen, Gorrie's addition to Payette thence south to the center of the alley in block ~~fifteen~~ Gorrie's addition to Payette, thence west to the east side of Pence street, thence north to the south west corner of said block seventeen thence west to the place of beginning.

Section VII. That a sidewalk shall be constructed on the east side of Park street between Ada avenue and Grand avenue.

Section VIII. That a sidewalk shall be constructed on the north side of Grand Avenue between Park street and King street, and that the Local Improvement District No. 6 is hereby established, bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the north west corner of block eleven, ~~Original Townsite of Payette,~~ thence south to the south-west corner of said block, thence east to the south east corner of block seventeen, thence west to the center of said block eleven, thence north to the south line of Ada avenue, thence west to the place of beginning.

*Thence N. to center of the alley in said block. 17*

Section IX. That a sidewalk shall be constructed on the North side of Tioga street between front street and the Depot Platform of the Oregon Short Line Rail Way Company, and that Local Improvement District No. 7 is hereby established, bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the north west corner of block ten Gorrie's addition to Payette, thence east to the platform of the Oregon Short Line Rail Way Company, thence south-westerly along said platform to the north line of Tioga street thence west to the south west corner of said block ten thence north to the place of beginning.

Section X. The sidewalks mentioned in sections two and four of this ordinance shall be six feet wide. ~~Section three, Ordinance eighteen, On Boise street between Ada avenue and Mill street, the sidewalks shall be six feet wide,~~ measuring from the line of the block to the outside of the curb, there shall be not less than four sills of not less than ~~two~~ by ~~six~~ inches in dimension, and these sills shall be supported by good substantial foundation. The covering shall be plank, not less than two inches thick, and shall be six or eight inches wide, and shall be laid crosswise of the walk, and securely fastened with not less than thirty penny nails where two inch plank is used, and ~~not~~ less than forty penny plank where thicker plank is used, and eight nails to each plank in all cases.

The inside or block line shall be two inches higher than the curb, and shall be graded with earth within four inches of the covering plank.

Section XI. The sidewalks mentioned in sections ~~one, five, six, and seven~~ of this ordinance shall be five feet four inches wide. ~~Under plan two, section IV, Ordinance number eighteen, the sidewalks shall be not less than five feet four inches wide.~~ There shall be not less than three sills of not less than ~~two~~ ~~six~~ inches in dimension, which sills shall be laid upon a good and substantial foundation. The outside line or curb shall be eight feet from the block line except where trees are established, and then, as may be ordered by the council. The covering shall ~~not be~~ less than one and one half inches thick, of plank laid crosswise of the walk, and shall be securely fastened with not less than thirty penny nails, six nails to each plank, in all cases. The grade of the walk shall be such as may be established by the street committee.

Section XII. The sidewalks mentioned in sections three, eight, and nine of this ordinance shall be four feet wide. ~~Under plan three of section four, Ordinance number eighteen the sidewalk shall be not less than four feet wide;~~ there shall be not less than two sills of not less than ~~two~~ by ~~six~~ inches in dimension, which sills shall be laid upon a good and substantial foundation. The outside line or curb line shall be eight feet from the block line, except where trees are established, and then, as may be ordered by the council. The covering shall not be less than one and one half inches thick, of plank laid crosswise of the walk, and shall be securely fastened with not less than thirty penny nails, four nails to the plank in all cases. The grade of the walk shall be such as may be established by the street committee.

Section XIII. The sidewalks required to be built by this ordinance may be constructed by the persons whose property is liable therefor, provided the same are constructed as provided herein, within thirty days from the passage of this ordinance, but if any of the said sidewalks are not so constructed within said thirty days the same will be constructed by the city of Payette, and the cost and expense thereof shall be taxed and assessed upon all the property in the local improvement district liable therefor, which cost shall be assessed in proportion to the number of feet of such lands and lots fronting hereon and included in the improvement district in which the same falls and in proportion to the benefits derived by said improvements.
