

ORDINANCE NO. 400

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE NO. 396 AND LIMITING THE TIME WHEN BEER MAY BE SOLD, GIVEN AWAY OR OTHERWISE DISPOSED OF AND/OR CONSUMED UPON THE PREMISES OF A RETAIL DEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section I, That Section 7 of ~~the~~ Ordinance No. 396, as passed by the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, and approved by the mayor of said city, on the 7th day of August, 1933, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7.--- It shall be unlawful for any retailer to suffer or permit any person under the age of 18 years to consume beer, as defined in this ordinance, ~~either~~ upon his premises, or for any retailer to sell, give away or in any wise dispose of such beer to any person under the age of 18 years, or for any retailer to sell, give away or dispose of any such beer, ~~or~~ to permit any such beer as defined in this ordinance to be consumed by any person in or upon his premises at any time between midnight and six o'clock A. M.,
