

ORDINANCE NO. 42

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT THE CITY TREASURER SHALL BE EX-OFFICIO TAX COLLECTOR OF SPECIAL TAXES OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE? AND FIXING THE METHOD OF COLLECTING TAXES AND HIS COMPENSATION AS SUCH TAX COLLECTOR.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section One. That the City Treasurer of the City of Payette shall be ex-officio tax collector of said City ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ and as such tax collector shall collect all special assessment taxes now levied, or hereafter to be levied in said City, the collection of which is not, by law, imposed upon the County Assessor and ex-officio Tax Collector of <sup>Langdon</sup> ~~Washington~~ County, Idaho.

Section Two. The said City Treasurer and ex-officio tax collector shall collect all taxes which it is herein made his duty to collect, in the same manner as is provided by law for the collecting of State and County taxes by the County Assessor and ex officio tax collector

Section Three. The said City Treasurer and ex-officio tax collector shall receive the same compensation for collecting such taxes as it is herein made his duty to collect, as is now, by <sup>law,</sup> allowed to the County Assessor and Tax Collector for Collecting State and County Taxes.
