

Annual appropriation Ordinance.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday of May, 1904,

Section 1. That there is hereby levied against all the taxable property within the limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 1 mills on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized together with all licenses and fines, from such levy shall be placed in the General fund of the said City of Payette.

Section 2. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday of May, 1904, against all the taxable property within the limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 5/2 mills on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Salary fund of the said City of Payette.

Section 3. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday of May, 1904, against all the taxable property within the limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 3/2 mills on each One Dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Road fund of the said City of Payette.
