

ORDINANCE NO. 6.

An ordinance fixing the time and place of holding regular meetings, and manner of calling special meetings of the council.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette.

Section I. The regular meetings of the council shall be held at the City Hall, on the first Thursday of each and every month.

Section II. Special meetings may be called by the Mayor, or by three members of the council.

Section III. When the mayor or any three members of the council desire to call a special meeting, he or they shall give written notices to the clerk, at least 24 hours before the time of meeting, stating the time and object of the special meeting. It shall be the duty of the clerk to notify all members of the council and the mayor, provided that said notice shall be given by him at least twelve hours before the time of said meeting. The call and object, as well as the disposition thereof, shall be entered upon the journal by the clerk, and the notices shall be served by the clerk

by oral notice, or, by delivering written notice to each member in person, or by leaving the same at each member's usual place of abode at least twelve hours before the time of said meeting.

Section IV. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
