

ORDINANCE NO. 8.

An ordinance concerning the oath of office.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette;

Section I. The various officers of the City of Payette shall take and subscribe, before some person authorized to administer oaths such oath as is required by law of municipal officers, which oath shall be filed with the City Clerk. No officer of the City shall enter upon the performance of his duties until he shall have so subscribed to, and filed such oath as stated above.

Section II. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 9.

An ordinance requiring official bonds of certain officers of the City of Payette.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette;

Section I. The clerk, treasurer, police judge, and marshal, before entering upon the duties of their offices, shall file with the clerk, good and sufficient bonds with sufficient sureties, to be approved by the council, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of their respective offices, in the following amounts;

The clerk, in the sum of five hundred dollars.

The treasurer, in the sum of three thousand dollars.

The police judge, in the sum of five hundred dollars.

The marshal, in the sum of five hundred dollars.

Section II. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
