

ORDINANCE NO. 82.

An Ordinance prohibiting the jumping on or from or riding upon a moving engine, car, caboose, without the permission of the conductor, within the corporate limits of the city of Payette, and providing the penalty for the violation thereof.

Be It Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the city of Payette:

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, within the corporate limits of the city of Payette, without the permission of the conductor to jump on, or from, or to ride upon a train of railroad cars, or any car or engine or part of such train, while the same is in motion.

Sec. 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars, and in default of payment of same, shall be confined in the City Jail one day for each and every Two Dollars of said fine.
