

ORDINANCE NO. 87.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO ~~THE~~ PAYETTE IRRIGATION COMPANY, LIMITED, A CORPORATION, THE RIGHT TO BUILD, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN, WATER-PIPE LINES AND WATER SYSTEMS IN THAT PORTION OF PAYETTE CITY LYING NORTH OF MAIN STREET, AND SAID STREET EXTENDED.

Be It Ordained, by the Mayor, and the city council of Payette:

Whereas, the Payette Irrigation Company, Limited, a corporation, has heretofore owned and operated, an Irrigation Ditch system in the form of open ditches, on and over the various streets and alleys of said City, lying north of Main Street, and said street extended, for the purpose of irrigating the lands embraced within said portion of Payette City,

And whereas said system as heretofore operated has been more or less unsightly and inconvenient to the public, and whereas said Company now proposes to place the main line of said system under ground, with lateral pipes and ditches, extending from said main line, and hereafter operate the same under pressure, for the purposes as heretofore used and operated and whereas, said changes will be of great benefit to the City of Payette and the public in general, and the owners and patrons of said ditch system,

Now in consideration of the premises, there is hereby granted to said Payette Irrigation Company, Limited, the right to build, operate, and maintain water-pipe lines and water systems, for the purpose of conveying and distributing irrigation water, under pressure, to its stockholders and patrons, on lands in said City, lying north of Main Street and said street extended. The Main line of said system to be located as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Lower Payette Ditch, at or near where the South side line of the North 1/2 of the North 1/2 of Section 34, Township 9 north Range 5 west Boise Meridian crosses said ditch: Thence West to Park Street: Thence in a South-westerly direction across said Park Street to Tioga Street: Thence west on Toiga Street to Gorrie's Lane: Thence North on Gorrie's Lane to North side of Wilhelm Street: Thence in a North-westerly direction on Gorrie's Lane to South side of H. S. Loveland' place: Thence in a Westerly direction to Snake River.

Together with lateral lines and ditches on, over and along any of the streets or alleys of said City lying North of Main Street and said street extended.

Said main and lateral water-pipe lines to be properly constructed and maintained, under ground, and the waters therein conducted not to be permitted to flood or damage any of said streets or alleys, and the location of all of said pipe lines on said streets shall be under the direction of the Mayor and City Council.
