ORDINANCE NO. 92 BY W P Ackerman

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REPAIR OF SIDEWALKS.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. All sidewalks that have been, or may hereafter be, constructed in the City of Payette by order of the Mayor and Council shall be kept in a good state of repair by supplying broken or decayed boards, sills or other parts, or by filling holes in a cement walk, so that it may in all cases meet the requirements of the specifications ordering it laid, and at all times be in a safe condition.

Section 2. On failure to keep a sidewalk in repair the owner or occupant shall be notified of the defects by the overseer of streets, if unknown, by notice in the official paper of the city, to repair same and if it is not repaired in a reasonable time, then the city may repair it and the expenses shall be assessed against the abutting property owner or owners by certifying same to the tax assessor to be collected as other city taxes.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
