ORDINANCE NO. 97 BY C. E. Braum

AN ORDINANCE OPENING TIOGA STREET BETWEEN BOISE STREET AND FRONT STREET AND REQUIRING SIDEWALKS TO BE CONSTRUCTED ALONG SAID STREET AS OPENED.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That Tioga Street be, and the same is hereby extended and opened from Boise Street West to the place of intersection of said Tioga Street with Front Street on the West side of O. S. L. Railroad right of way, the said extension and opening shall be one hundred feet in width.

Section 2. Sidewalks shall be constructed on the North and South sides of Tioga Street as the same is extended and opened between Boise Street and Front Street, said sidewalks shall be four feet in width, laid with two sills 3X4 inches in size, covered with 2X6 inch plank, and nailed with 30D nails, 4 nails to each plank, and shall in all respects conform to plan 3 of section 5 ordinance No. 18 of the City of Payette.

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1907, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of one mill on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy, together with all licenses and fines, shall be placed in the general fund of the said City of Payette.

Section 2. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1907, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 3 1/2 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the road fund of the said City of Payette.

Section 3. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1907, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 5 1/2 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the salary fund of the City of Payette.

Section 4. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1907, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 4 1/2 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Water Works Bonds Interest fund and be expended from interest that has accrued or may accrue on the Thirty Thousand Dollar Municipal Coupon Water Works Bonds heretofore issued by the City of Payette.

Section 5. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1907, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 1/2 mill
