

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE 1439

Ordinance 1439 is an ordinance of the City Of Payette, Idaho, adopted February 20, 2018. The ordinance may be descriptively known as the Payette Beer and Wine License Adjustment ordinance. Ordinance 1439 amends sections 5.04.020 and 5.04.080 of Title 5 of the Payette Municipal Code by eliminating the requirement of obtaining licenses from the council and by eliminating the expiration date of December 31 of each year for beer and wine licenses. Ordinance 1439 provides a severability clause, provides for publication by summary, sets an effective date, creates a penalty for violations and establishes a repealer.
