

ORDINANCE NO. 1448

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO; BY AMENDING TITLE 6, CHAPTER 4, SECTION 6.04.020 AND 6.04.060 TO ADD LLAMAS AS AN ANIMAL THAT CAN BE SEIZED AND IMPOUNDED UNDER ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS; AND PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY, AND ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Title 6, Chapter 6.04, Section 6.04.020 of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.04.020: ANIMALS; RUNNING AT LARGE; NOTICE OF SEIZURE AND IMPOUNDMENT:

No cattle, horses, mules, hogs, llamas, goats or sheep shall be allowed to run at large, or be herded, tethered or picketed in any of the streets, alleys or public grounds within the City limits; and it is made and shall be the duty of the Chief of Police to seize and impound any and all cattle, horses, mules, hogs, llamas, goats or sheep found tethered, picketed or running at large within the City limits.

6.04.060: ANIMALS; SEIZED AND IMPOUNDED; FEES:

The Chief of Police shall collect the actual and necessary expenses incurred for seizing, impounding, keeping and selling any animal under the provisions of this chapter:

- A. For taking up and impounding cattle, horses, mules and llamas, per head;
- B. For hogs, sheep and goats, per head. (Ord. 1433, 2017)

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.
