A RESOLUTION OF THE PAYETTE CITY COUNCIL  
TO CALCULATE PROPOSED COLA BASED UPON THE  
CONSUMER PRICE INDEX-URBAN (CPI-U)

WHEREAS, the Payette City Council wishes to establish a method to calculate the annual cost of living allowance ("COLA") for employees for budget purposes; and,


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the COLA shall be calculated based upon the Consumer Price Index – Urban (CPI-U), in accordance with the Idaho Department of Labor recommendation that the national CPI-U is typically used to measure inflation in Idaho because it more closely represents our cost of living; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the employee COLA shall be calculated based on the twelve-month CPI-U average from May to April preceding the budget preparation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette will base proposed COLA for budgeting purposes on the CPI-U average for the ending in the month of April.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to calculate employee salaries commensurate with the April CPI-U (released in June) each year for budgeting purposes.
